

Cettina Donato Sextet, Cum Passi 'Dda, Jazz Revelation Records, Boston, MA, USA, 2011

Messina (Italy). Great success with wonderful jazz for Summer Music Festival 2011 by "V. Bellini Association" at the great location of the Amphitheater of Culture. Leading musicians the piano player and composer Cettina Donato, bass player Marco Panascia and the drummer Marcello Pellitteri. Despite the rain threat and the windy night, audience came copiously and celebrated with enthusiasm the musicians but especially the fellow citizen, the pianist Cettina Donato who denied the proverb that says that a prophet is never respected in his own home. The Cettina Donato's compositions, composed for most of all during the sojourn in the United States at Berklee College of Music, are beautiful and charming, spontaneous and it's possible to see how the pianist Cettina Donato knows the tradition but uses also a new way to describe her music. Tunes such Pentanights, Sugar & Paper, Goodfaith hit the audience's hearts being simple just in the appearance but with a great writing skills. The audience loved Cettina not just as composer but as piano player as well, punctual, precise, well sustained by two of the most important musicians internationally recognized such Marco Panascia and Marcello Pellitteri. Two Italian artists that live in the United States. Listening to this three musicians was a pleasure especially for those who love jazz music. Listening jazz music to this high level is not a common thing in this city. The Cettina Donato's concert with Marco Panascia and Marcello Pellitteri has perfectly concluded the music season of the Bellini Association with a happy audience at the Culture Amphitheater.



## MAINSTAGE **Cettina Donato** Jazz Trio



**Cettina Donato** is a piano player and composer. She released her first CD PRISITNE edited by Wide Sound Label (Italy). She was selected by Jazz Revelation Label as new jazz artist on 2011 (Boston, MA) and she recorded a composition which can be found on CD called OCTAVE (released by Jazz Revelation label). She was awarded from Jazz Composition Major (Berklee College) for her achievements as jazz pianist and composer. She's graduated from Berklee College of Music majoring in Jazz Composition. She has a Degree in Classical and Jazz Piano and a Degree in Social Psychology. She has been playing for Berklee College of Music at Umbria Jazz Festival (Italy, 2010 until 2012) and besides she's piano accompanist for Boston Ballet School. **Cettina** started playing with Giuseppe Paradiso (*Drums*) and Andrew Dow (Bass) since they were studying at Berklee College of Music. The trio performed for several concerts at Berklee. It's important to mention: The Best of Jazz Composition 1 Concert, Jazz Revelation Concert at Berklee Performance Center, Cettina Donato Quartet at Spectacle Island (Boston, MA) and they performed for the Jazz Revelation Records (2011).

Review of my first album **PRISTINE** (Wide Sound Label, 2008)

**Cettina Donato**, soft and deep pianist, generous and fine composer, a musician able to describe with no matters the Mediterranean feeling which wants mystery and carnality get together with a persuasive lyricism. **Cettina** debuts with her first album. Five tunes are hers, she writes all the arrangements for a jazz quintet, surrounded by musicians such an excellent Paride Furzi on Double Bass and the wonderful Jerry Popolo on Tenor and Soprano Saxes.

When you listen to Cettina's album you discover a line going through fifty minutes of the musical program, you can listen to a passionate strength, a passion for jazz music so intense that it seems getting out from colors, flavors, profiles of a beloved land. So, it seems that, even if the album doesn't seem to have any formal "news", it appears absolutely necessary, legitimate son of the contemporary music.

Listening to the tracks of the album you discover a divertissement of *Cum Passi 'Dda* (between tango and funny variation of a blues), the moody feeling of *Stromboli*, a *Waltz Time* who seems coming out from a Bill Evans' album, the swing vitality of *Conchita Blues*, the irreverence of *Summertime* and *A Night In Tunisia*, two jazz standards folded, dissected, distilled, combined by the pianist. But, it's in *Mel Lewis* (by pianist Salvatore Bonafede) that the pianist **Cettina Donato** walks with autorithy, essentiality, punctuality, inflexibility.
